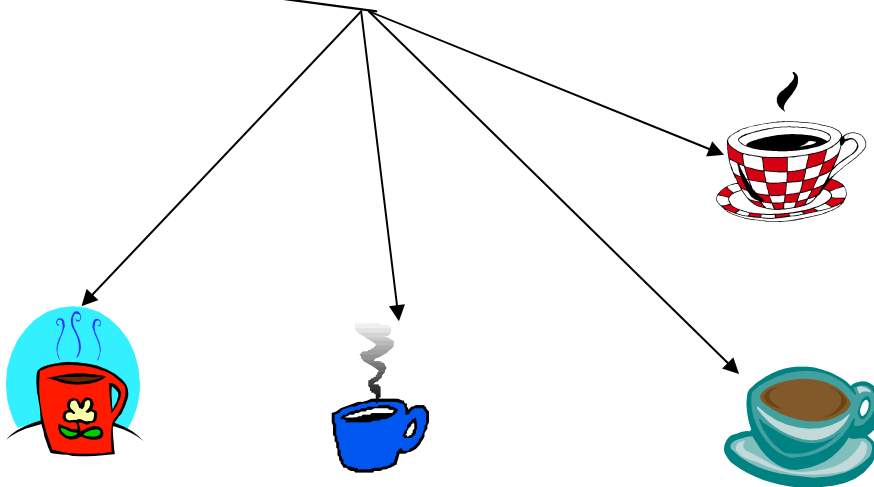

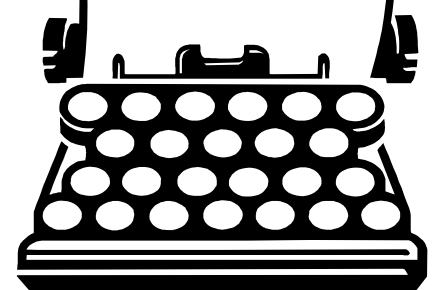
March's meeting is Model Night, featuring members eclectic collections and models and more. An often challenging and always entertaining evening.
