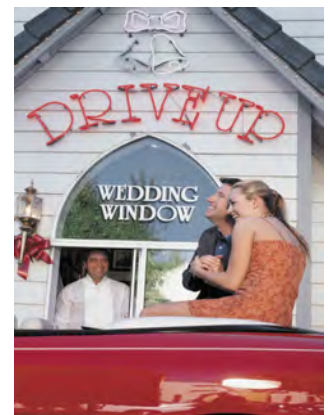

**Saturday, May 4th, is "Drive Your MG or Jaguar Day"**

On May 4th, members of CCMGC/CXKJR will fire up their classic cars to take a drive in the countryside to blow away the cobwebs.
