## GUEST SPEAKERS AT THE JUNE 9 MEMBERSHIP MEETING

**Cam Henderson** from JP Autogroup in Surrey is presenting the **Hyundai Fuel Cell Vehicle** and will be talking about the technology on a basic level.

The vehicle is schedule to arrive at the Clubhouse at 6:45PM.

**Colin Armstrong** from HTEC (Hydrogen Technology & Energy Corporation) will be talking about Hydrogen fuel. HTEC develops, owns and operates hydrogen delivery systems and vehicle fuelling stations.

**The focus of the presentation will be on where the technology is today and what we can expect from it in the future.**

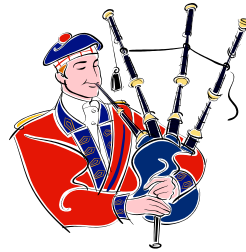
## IT'S SUMMER AND HERE ARE A FEW MORE EVENTS OF INTEREST!
