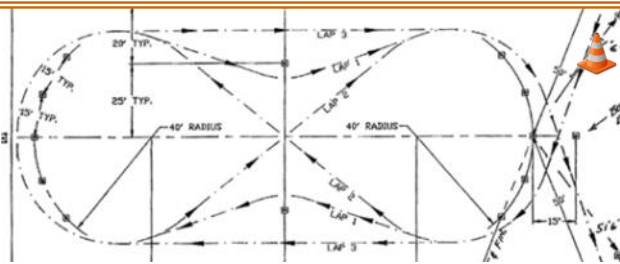


FATHER'S DAY PICNIC JUNE 19

'51 Riley RMB Saloon 2.5L LHD for sale: \$7,000

With a nod to its marketing moniker *As Old As The Industry, As Modern As The Hour*, this car extends the legacy of its late long-time steward, Bill Lewis, a go-to Riley Master. Whilst serving the Eight Army Air Corps in England during World War II Bill was introduced to Riley (Coventry) Limited and began a lifelong passion for the marque. Bill's Riley served as the obvious transportation choice to bring their newborn daughter home from the hospital, later, for her wedding and then to bring grandbabies home from the hospital. Lingered in a garage for at least a decade, the car is ready to be brought back to safe drivability so it may continue as an aspirational car for a working class demographic, or, with proper attention, into a grand dame of a show car. Relatively rare as a LHD for the US market, (one of 145 produced in 1951 all global export markets) this car is ready to be revived and reunited as a member of a large, mostly across-the-pond daily-driver cousins, dutifully serving as a representative of a relatively under-represented marque associated with durability, reliability and affordable classic British automotive design. 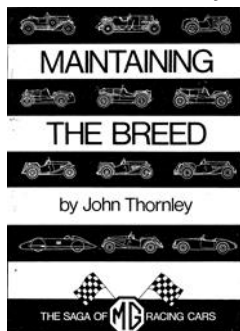
