### Studio and Gallery Tour by VISUALS

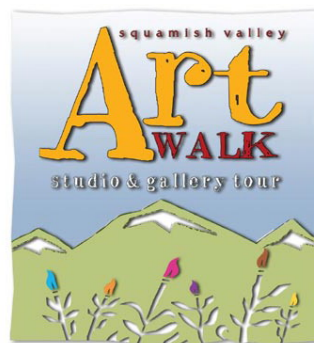
