## GT32 Followup



WOW! What a great GT32 event – 120 cars and 300 people. Star of the show was EX186, an MGA Special built in 1958 to win Le Mans, but never raced, and then smuggled out the back door of the factory to save it from being scrapped when the factory was closed. Found its way to California, where it lay in a barn for over 40 years. This was the first time this stunning car had been in Canada. Alongside this was an ex-Sebring MGA (#38), that had its restoration completed just a week before the event.

The GT32 organizing team received many accolades from the attendees – thanks to all from CCMGC and CXKJR who helped to make this event the best GT ever. We incorporated some new features that will be adopted by GT organizers in the future. And speaking of the future, GT33 will be in June 2008 in Pennsylvania, just south of Pittsburgh (details in CG soon).
