"I came across an amazing reference tool on the internet.

There is a company, <http://www.advanceautowire.com/mgb.pdf> that offers new wiring harnesses for sale to fit a variety of MGBs and Triumphs. More importantly for us maintainers though, this company has graciously posted all stock wiring diagrams for the MGB - in colour! Having coloured wires on the diagram makes a circuit much easier to follow, so I've always coloured mine with felt pens. The diagrams for the MGB come in PDF format, sized for 8.5 X 11 paper, so anyone with a colour printer can bang themselves off a copy.

They say they'll be adding schematics for more cars soon, but I guess those of us with MGAs and Jaguars will have to stick to felt pens for now!

Additionally, there will also be a "Touring Class" for those who merely wish to drive a modified rally route without the challenges of interpreting "rally language" or staying on time.

An additional new development this year is posting the General Instructions on the host club's website. Rallyes are traditionally governed by a combination of these "Generals" and the Route Instructions. The Route Instructions are distributed just shortly before the beginning of the rally, but the General Instructions need to be studied and understood in advance, so they'll be available to everyone well in advance where they can be downloaded and printed.
