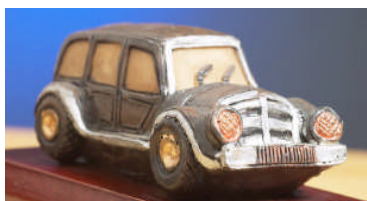
The "Rules" for the event

- Again this year there will be time & space for MODEL SWAP & SHOP - so bring your spares and be prepared to dicker-trade, buy & sell!

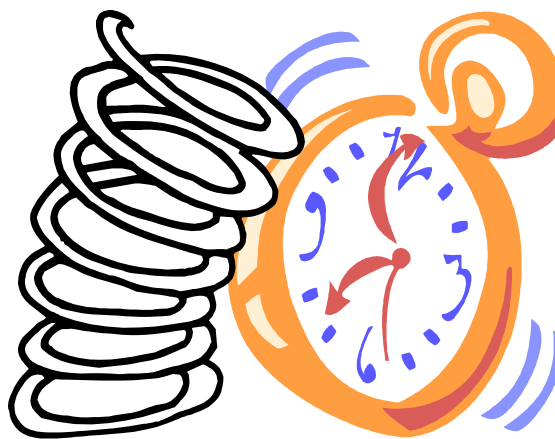
