A number of parks in North & West Vancouver will be on the route, incorporating some major North Shore parks, but also some new ones and a few that are "hidden". This is a scenic drive, not a rally, so come out and enjoy the roads and the views.

Gathering time at the start will be 9:30 am, with the first car leaving at 10:00 am.

Are you planning on joining our group drive to Calgary and back? Here's our plan.

We will drive to Calgary taking the southern route with two overnight stops. Our return trip will be quicker, taking a more central route with one stop over.


### To Calgary:

**Saturday, July 15<sup>th</sup>** - leave from the Burnaby Lake Rugby Clubhouse stopping for the night in Grand Forks. Approximately 6 hours drive time. 510 kms.

**Sunday, July 16<sup>th</sup>** – drive to Cranbrook for an overnight stay. Approximately 4 and half hours drive time. 320 kms.

**Monday, July 17<sup>th</sup>** – drive to Calgary. Approximately 4 and a quarter hours drive time. 384 kms

Additional time will be planned for breaks, fuel, jumping jacks.


### Return trip:

**Friday, July 21<sup>st</sup>** – leave Calgary and drive to Revelstoke for an overnight stay. Approximately 5 hours drive time. 423 kms.

**Saturday, July 22<sup>nd</sup>** - Drive to Burnaby and home. Approximately 6 and a half hours drive time. 565 kms.

The plan is to return by way of the Nicola Valley to Merritt and the Coldwater by-pass (south of Merritt) for a more scenic run home.

Additional time will be planned for breaks, fuel and more stretching.

Notify Mike McChesney that you plan to travel with the CCMGC group. Mike will then send you the hotel information so that you can make your bookings.
