

Are You Planning to Drive Long Distances in Your Classic in 2024?

CXKJR/CCMGC is a member of the British Car Council of Canada and thus award opportunities become available to our members. Each year the Council offers Long Distance Awards to club members who have driven at least 3,000 miles (4830 kms) in their classic British car between Jan 1 and Dec 31. If you drive two classic cars, you can combine the mileage you've driven in both of them to come up with a total miles driven. Classics do not include British cars considered to be daily drivers unless they are 15 or more years old.

If you think you might drive at least 3000 miles in your classic British car(s) in 2024, take a photo of your odometer on January 1, 2024 or if you have your classic in winter storage, take the photo before you take her out for the first time in the spring. If you end up driving at least 3000 miles in 2024, you will then need to take a photo of your odometer on December 31, 2024 or when you put the car away for the winter. Any member who ends up driving the required 3000 miles in 2024 will be nominated by the CXKJR/CCMGC Executive for a British Car Council of Canada Long Distance Award.
