It takes a relatively large and committed group of people to consistently provide our members with an award-winning publication. My heartfelt thanks goes to all of them.



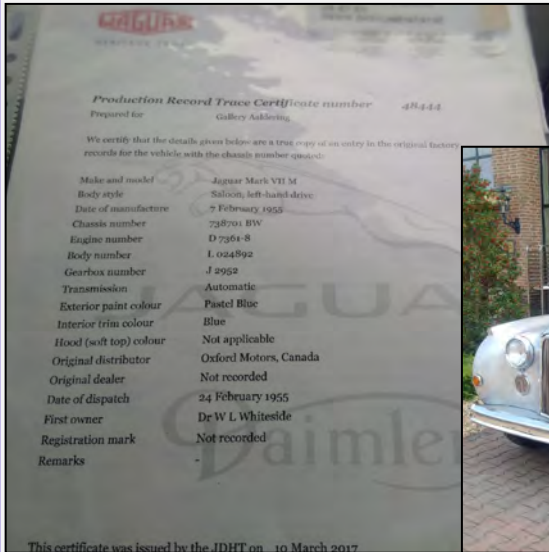

NAN HEATHER—1933—2021

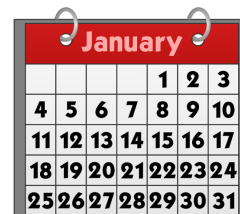

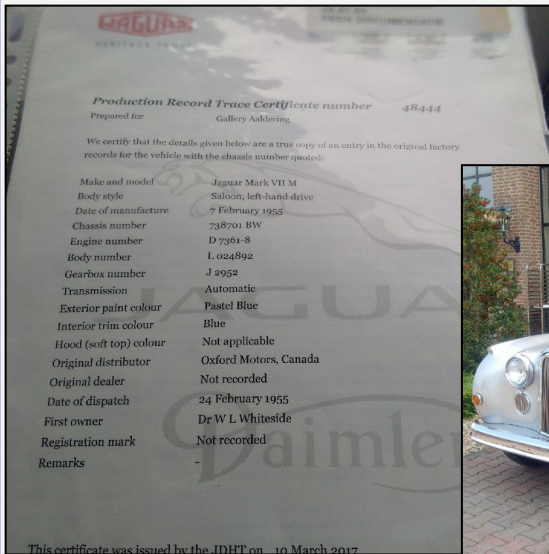
