The term of office for next year's Executive positions is from the November 2024 AGM to the November 2025 AGM.



From the Senior Editor: Jennifer Orum

Classical Gas is in its 55 th year of publication, having been started by Ian Newby in June 1970 a few months after CXKJR/CCMGC was born. An award-winning publication, Classical Gas is a major contributor to the success of our club.

I started as Senior Editor in January 2008. After 17 years, while I continue to enjoy the role and find it rewarding, it's time for another club member to have the opportunity, fun and adventure of overseeing the magazine. There are lots of benefits to being Senior Editor – you get to know what is happening everywhere in the club and have the satisfaction of ensuring that our membership is both informed and entertained through the magazine's content. Each time a new issue is published, you'll get a wonderful sense of accomplishment.

I have given notice to the club Executive that I will do the November/December and January/February issues, but as of the March/April issue another member needs to be involved in the Senior Editor role. My plan is to work with the new volunteer through a transition period of one or more issues, during which we can both be carrying out editing tasks as Co-Editors, and I can orient the volunteer to all aspects of the Senior Editor position.

The Senior Editor role involves overseeing the production cycle and controlling the content and organization of the 6 bi-monthly issues, as well as editing articles and selecting photos. In addition to effective communication and writing skills, the Senior Editor needs either some experience in editing or an interest in learning it. The position requires use of Microsoft Word, but it is not necessary to be familiar with publishing software such as Adobe Indesign or Microsoft Publisher, since the layout and design of the magazine are done by a professional design firm.

The Senior Editor has a very supportive team carrying out various roles: an Ad Manager responsible for finding new advertisers, a member responsible for Classical Gas Distribution, two people assisting with editing articles, and an active, effective Classical Gas Advisory Committee. Layout, design, printing and mailing are handled by Infigo Imaging.

To ensure the continuation of Classical Gas, a member needs to step forward by January 15, 2025

I currently carry out another role that will not be part of the Senior Editor position going forward. Managing advertiser renewals can be a standalone task and we are thus looking for a member to oversee the renewals of our 25+ advertisers throughout the year.




