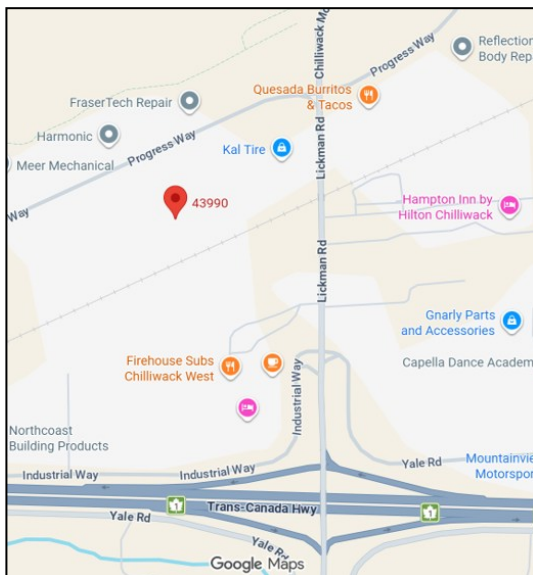
Date: Wednesday July 15th

Cars and socializing are the "driving" passion of our club and yours. But if you also have a passion for nature and beauty, you may find the following especially interesting.

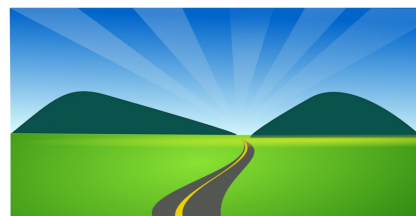
We are pleased to announce the 2026 Brits Down the Coast classic British car tour.

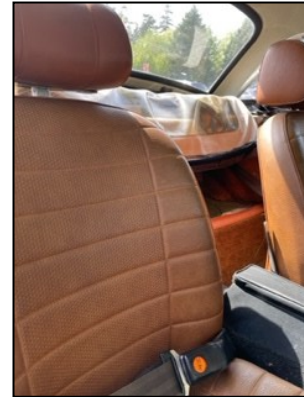
